DECISION

This case is before the Public Employment Relations Board (hereafter PERB) on the basis of Charging Party's attempt to file an amended brief in support of his exceptions to the proposed decision of the hearing officer.

Appellant offered no explanation for the late filing and therefore the extraordinary circumstances which would justify the filing of the brief as required by PERB Rule 32133<sup>1</sup> have not been demonstrated.

<sup>1</sup>PERB rules are codified at title 8, section 31000 et seq. of the California Administrative Code. PERB rule 32133 reads:

A late filing may be excused in the discretion of the Board only under extraordinary circumstances.

PERB Rule 32300(a) governs the filing of exceptions and briefs in support thereof.<sup>2</sup>

ORDER

The Board ORDERS that the filing of Joseph James Catalfano's amended brief in support of his exceptions to the proposed decision of the hearing officer is hereby DENIED.

<sup>2</sup>Section 32300(a) provides:

A party may file with the Board itself an original and four copies of a statement of exceptions to a Board agent's proposed decision issued pursuant to Section 32215, and supporting brief, within 20 days following the date of service of the decision. . . . (Emphasis added.)
