DECISION AND ORDER

SHANK, Member: On August 11, 1989, California Union of Safety Employees (CAUSE) filed a Request for Stay of Activity Pending Resolution of Appeal to the Public Employment Relations Board (Board). CAUSE requested the Board to stay further activity in Case No. S-UM-412-S pending its decision on the appeal of the Board agent's dismissal of the unfair practice charge in Case No. S-CE-425-S. The Board, after full review of the issue, including CAUSE's appeal from dismissal of the unfair practice charge, request for stay, and State of California, Department of Personnel Administration's Statement of Opposition to Appeal from Dismissal and Request for Stay, denies CAUSE's request for a stay.

CAUSE's request for stay of all proceedings is hereby DENIED.
