DECISION AND ORDER

The request of the Los Angeles Unified School District that the Public Employment Relations Board (hereafter Board) refrain from issuing a complaint in the above-captioned matter pursuant to Government Code section 3541.5(a) is DENIED because there is no agreement between the parties containing grievance machinery that covers the matter at issue. The Board finds that the contract between the parties expired on its own terms on September 1, 1980, and was not extended thereafter.

The request for injunctive relief filed by United Teachers-Los Angeles is DENIED, sufficient grounds therefor not having been demonstrated to the Board.
